Ribbon Cutting Ceremony to Celebrate Englewood's Various Park Improvements

ENGLEWOOD, N.J. - The City of Englewood will hold a ribbon cutting ceremony on Tuesday, July 1, 2008 at 7pm at Mackay Park basketball courts to represent the re-opening of the newly renovated court facilities.

The City received \$353,125 in grant funding from the County's Open Space Trust Fund for the improvement of various municipal parks and playgrounds. These funds have been matched by \$333,333 in City funding. In April of 2008, the City Council awarded two contracts to D & L Land Development totaling \$583,318 for various park improvements and the reconstruction of basketball courts.

The first phase of these improvements is the reconstruction of Mackay park basketball courts. The second phase includes replacing playground equipment, fencing and athletic facilities in Mackay, Trumball, Triangle, Madison Avenue and Denning Park. New bleachers will be installed in Tryon and Morris Avenue Park. Once all work is complete, the City's park facilities will comply with new safety standards and provide new and exciting play opportunities for the youth of the community.
