

**CITY OF ENGLEWOOD**

**BOARD OF HEALTH REGULAR MEETING**

**April 15, 2015**

1. The regular meeting of the Board of Health, City of Englewood, Bergen County, was called to order at 8:04 p.m. by JoEllen Bostick, President, Board of Health.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

JoEllen Bostick, President; Dr. Lisa Wisotsky, Vice President (arrived 8:10); Bertha-Nora Acosta; Daniel Daniel; Stephanie Davis; and Ketsia Alerte-Sadler.

**ALSO PRESENT:**

James Fedorko, Director, Health Services/Health Officer/Secretary to the Board; Richard A. Lustgarten, Esq., Board of Health Attorney; and Janet Hart, Confidential Executive Secretary.

**ABSENT/with apology:**

Dr. Aliza Solomon.

Mr. Fedorko read the Open Public Meetings Statement. All stood to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. A. Items for Approval

Motion to approve 2. A. i. (Minutes of March 11, 2015 Meeting); 2. A. ii. (Receipts – March, 2015 - \$35,998.50); 3. A. iii. (Bills – March, 2015 - \$7,583.75); 3. A. iv. (Employee Reports – March, 2015); 3. A. v. (Digest of Mail – March, 2015); and 3. A. vi. (Communications, March, 2015).

Motion to approve Items 2. A. i. – vi. was made by Ms. Davis, and seconded by Ms. Acosta. Motion was approved 5-0.

2. B. Motion to approve retail licenses – March, 2015

Mr. Lustgarten stated that since there were 136 licenses to be approved, instead of reading them, they would be attached to the minutes as "Schedule A," with the Board's approval. Motion to approve retail licenses for March 1, 2015 through April 2, 2015 was made by Mr. Daniel, and seconded by Ms. Sadler. Mr. Fedorko said that there had not been any written or verbal objection to the approval of these licenses. Motion was approved 5-0.

2. C. i. Board Liaison Reports

Ms. Davis, Board of Education Liaison, suggested that, going forward, she would meet with the School Superintendent at the beginning of the school year, sharing with him/her what the Department had tentatively planned to do. The Board members agreed with her suggestion.

2. C. ii. Committee Reports

Speaking on behalf of the Obesity Committee, Mr. Fedorko stated that on April 20, 2015, the opening ceremony of the Walk with a Leader program will be held at 7:00 p.m., at Winton White Stadium. The "Healthy Town" designation from the New Jersey Health Care Quality Institute will be presented to Mayor Huttle and Ms. JoEllen Bostick, President of the Englewood Board of Health. After the ceremony, participants will walk laps around the stadium with the community leaders in attendance.

**ORDINANCES**

3. 15-03 Maximum Salaries for 2015 and 2016 (Introduction)

Motion to read the ordinance by title only and authorize the reading of the introduction was made by Ms. Sadler, and seconded by Ms. Davis. Motion was approved 6-0.

Mr. Lustgarten stated that the title of Ordinance 15-03 is "An Ordinance Establishing the Salaries of the Department of Health of the City of Englewood as of January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016." He then read the Resolution to Introduce Ordinance 15-03, as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED that Ordinance No. 15-03 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing the Salaries of the Department of Health of the City of Englewood as of January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016" be introduced and does now pass a first reading, and that said ordinance be further considered for final passage at a regular meeting of the Board of Health to be held at the Department of Health, 73 South Van Brunt Street, Englewood, New Jersey, on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015, at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and at said time and place, all persons interested be given an opportunity to be heard concerning the same, and the Board Secreary is hereby authorized and directed to publish said ordinance according to law prior to said hearing with a notice of its introduction and of the time and place, when, and where said ordinance will be cosidered for final passage.

Motion to introduce Ordinance 15-03 was made by Ms. Davis, and seconded by Mr. Daniel. Motion was approved 6-0.

**RESOLUTIONS**

4. Resolution 15-09 – Appointment of Youth Health Educator

Mr. Lustgarten read Resolution 15-09, appointing Wonjun (John) Han as Youth Health Educator, for the Reach and Teach Program, effective March 23, 2015, in its entirety. Motion to approve

Resolution 15-09 was made by Ms. Sadler, and seconded by Ms. Acosta. Motion was approved 6-0.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

### 5. Bergen Volunteer Medical Initiative (BVMI)

Mr. Fedorko reported that the first intake clinic of Bergen Volunteer Medical Initiative (BVMI) was scheduled to take place at the Englewood Health Department on April 7, 2015, but was cancelled due to lack of participation. Mr. Lustgarten stated that the contract with BVMI shows the Department as "added insured." Mr. Fedorko said the next intake clinic is scheduled for April 21, 2015.

### 6. 2015 Budget

Mr. Fedorko told the Board that on March 18, 2015, the Department budget for 2015 was presented before the City Council. Ms. Bostick, Board of Health President, Dr. Wisotsky, Board of Health Vice President, and Ms. Baldwin, Program Coordinator/Assistant to Director were present at this meeting. Mr. Fedorko said the presentation went well, and that the area most in need of improvement is emergency preparation. Since then, he has met twice with Mr. Joe Sorbanelli, Emergency Management Coordinator for the City.

### 7. Restaurant Inspection Checklist

Mr. Fedorko reviewed the Retail Food Inspection checklist with the Board Members and the most important factors were discussed.

Mr. Fedorko mentioned that the Department had won a grant from NACCHO to standardize both the retail food inspection report and how we report communicable diseases. This entails a lot of work and some travelling for Health Inspectors Priscilla Lewis and Jennifer Galarza.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### 8. 2015 – 2016 Planning

Mr. Fedorko distributed copies of the activities planned for the years 2015-2016 by the Department, and discussed with the Board.

### 9. Probationary Status of PHN

Mr. Fedorko said he is recommending that Claudette Murdock, Public Health Nurse, be removed from probationary status. He stated that she has been with the Department since September, 2014, and asked for a consensus from the Board to change her employment status from probationary employee to regular employee. All members voted "Aye."

10. Other Business

The Board felt there should be a protocol to follow in certain medical situations when a physician is not present. Several suggestions were made and discussed, and Mr. Fedorko said he would follow up on them.

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Mr. Fedorko reminded the Board that their Financial Disclosure forms are due by April 30, 2015.

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Mr. Fedorko reported that the construction of the new firehouse should be completed in January, 2016, and that the Fire Department would be moving in by February, 2016. The entrance to the Health Department is being moved from the right side of the building to the front.

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Mr. Fedorko referred the Board to the draft of the Department's Annual Report they had received. Whereas, the Annual Report for 2014 for the Department of Health of the City of Englewood has been presented to the Board of Health by the Director, Health Services/Health Officer for approval, and whereas the Board has had an opportunity to review the report, be it resolved by the Board of Health of the City of Englewood that the 2014 Annual Report, as submitted, is approved. Motion to approve was made by Ms. Davis, and seconded by Mr. Daniel. Motion was approved 6-0.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Motion to open the time for public comment was made by Ms. Davis, and seconded by Ms. Sadler. Motion was approved 6-0.

Dr. Richard Pierson, 60 Lincoln Street

Dr. Pierson congratulated Dr. Wisotsky on her decision to run for City office, and stated the importance of public health matters in City government.

There were no further questions or comments from the public. Motion to close the time for public comment was made by Ms. Acosta, and seconded by Ms. Sadler. Motion was approved 6-0.

Mr. Lustgarten then read the Closed Session Resolution as follows:

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey permits the public to be excluded from certain matters to be discussed by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the City of Englewood desires to discuss contract negotiations and personnel issues; and

WHEREAS, these matters are ones which permit the exclusion of the public from such discussions; and

WHEREAS, minutes will be taken during the closed session, and a summary of the minutes will be made available to the public upon adoption of the final contract in contract negotiations, which is anticipated to be not later than eight weeks from today, and on the personnel issue, when the personnel issues are resolved, which are anticipated to be four weeks from today, and once the need for confidentiality no longer exists the minutes will be made available to the public,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Health of the City of Englewood that, the public be excluded since these matters, as set forth above, are ones which permit the exclusion of the public from such discussion: Collective bargaining agreement negotiations; and employment matters relating to any specific prospective or current employee unless the individual requests in writing that the matter be discussed in public.

Motion to begin the Closed Session was made by Ms. Davis, and seconded by Ms. Acosta. Motion was approved 6-0.

**(Closed Session)**

The Board discussed the renewal of the contract with Local Union 108 and the salaries of the Health Educator and the Health Officer/Director, Health Services.

**ADJOURN**

There being no further business to discuss, motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Bostick, and seconded by Dr. Wisotsky. All members voted "Aye," in favor. Motion was carried.

The meeting adjourned at 9:40 p.m.
