MECHANIC I

DEFINITION

Under direction of Master Mechanic, performs varied mechanical work involved in the maintenance and repair of motor vehicles and motorized equipment; performs related duties as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

- In the garage and in the field, does mechanical work on automobiles, trucks and other motorized and mechanized equipment, including road construction and maintenance equipment.
- Performs the work involved in the installation, maintenance and repair of motors, fuel systems, exhaust systems, cooling systems, electrical systems, suspension systems, steering systems, and instruments.
- . May be required to do welding.
- . Stores, records, safeguards and properly uses equipment, materials and supplies.
- . Keeps necessary records.
- . Adjusts operating mechanisms.
- Must be available for emergency call-back as scheduled.

OUALIFICATIONS

Education, Experience and Licenses

- Must have possession of a valid State of New Jersey Commercial Drivers License (CDL).
- . Must possess High School Diploma

- . 2 (two) years experience in the installation, maintenance and repair of varied types of motor vehicles and motorized equipment.
- . Must obtain ASE certification within one year of hire.

- Ability to analyze mechanical problems, organize assigned work, and develop effective work methods; to do mechanical work in the garage and in the field.
