The Englewood Police Department is pleased to announce the implementation of the School Safe Corridor Initiative. The initiative will begin Monday, September 22, 2014. The below outlines give a basic description of the structure of the program.

Objective:

- The main goal of this initiative is to provide passage ways that will have a visible police presence during arrival and dismissal of schools. This is to primarily address students in the school district that walk to and from school. This program is intended to provide a safe environment for school age children as they go to and leave from their respective schools. Our secondary focus will allow for officers to interact with children in the community. Additionally, we look to provide fast or immediate access to law enforcement should an emergency arise.

Schools:

- Grieco School, McCloud School, Janis Dismus Middle School, Dwight Morrow High School, Englewood Alternative School & Englewood on the Palisades Charter School

Named Streets:

- Knickerbocker Rd. From Ivy Lane to W. Palisades Ave.
- Tenafly Rd. From Ivy Lane to W. Palisades Ave.
- Liberty Rd. From Tenafly Rd. to West Hudson Ave.

Program Times:

- 7:30 am to 8:15 am (during scheduled school days)
- 2:30 pm to 3:15 pm “ “ “ “

Method of Delivery:

- Deployment of marked police vehicles in the vicinity of the named streets
- Supplemented with unmarked police vehicles and personnel assigned to the Youth Services Unit
- Officers will periodically stop and engage the youth in conversation in an effort to foster a community team building concept and a positive law enforcement image.
