RESOLUTION No. R14-13**

Be it resolved, by the Board of Health of the City of Englewood,

That the Board of Health recommends that the City Council adopt an ordinance which prohibits the use of tobacco and tobacco products with respect to outdoor cafes as specified herein:

An Ordinance amending Chapter 180 of the Code of the City Of Englewood, specifically Article II entitled Outdoor Cafes

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Englewood, NJ as follows:

1. Article II of Chapter 180 of the Code of the City of Englewood NJ be and it is hereby amended as follows.
2. Add Section 180-11 k --"No establishment which has been granted a license pursuant to Section 180-6 hereof shall permit, allow or authorize the use of any tobacco, or non-tobacco products commonly designated "e-cigarettes" or other similar products, in the area designated as an outdoor café of the establishment (as defined in section 180-4 hereof).
3. The establishment shall properly post in conspicuous places the ban as set forth in section 2.
4. Any establishment/licensee which violates this section shall be subject to the penalties and revocation of license as set forth in sections 180-14 and 180-15 hereof.
5. All other sections of Chapter 180 shall remain in full force and effect.
6. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication according to law.
