

**BOARD OF HEALTH
CITY OF ENGLEWOOD
ORDINANCE NO. 11-02**

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 6 OF THE HEALTH CODE OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, "FEES AND FEE SCHEDULE".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, THAT CHAPTER 6 OF THE HEALTH CODE BE REVISED AS FOLLOWS;

Chapter 6. Fees and Fee Schedule

SECTION 6.2 FEES FIXED

The licensing year fee for the several licenses or permits referred to in this Code are hereby fixed as follows:

| (a) Late fee for licenses when renewal applied for after April 1 of any year | \$50.00 for license \$250.00 and under OR \$100.00 for licenses over \$250.00 |
| (b) License reinstatement fee (after suspension or revocation of license | \$250.00 per reinstatement in addition to regular fees |
| (c) Excessive Conditional Rating Penalty Fee
Retail Food Service establishments and restaurants receiving two (2) or more conditional ratings in the previous license year shall be assessed a fine upon license renewal | 50 % of the normal license fee |
| (d) Re-inspection Penalty Fee
Retail Food Service establishments and restaurants receiving a second, subsequent, conditional rating shall immediately be assessed a fine | 50 % of the normal license fee |
| (e) Plan Review Fee | \$75.00 |

| Up to 3,000 sq. ft. | \$250.00 |
| 3,001 to 6,000 sq. ft. | \$300.00 |

(5) Sweets, candies, gum	\$40.00
(6) Temporary Food License	
Up to 3 days	\$75.00 (includes 1 inspection)
Up to 10 days	\$125.00 (includes 1 inspection)
Inspection fee only (applicable with 501(c)3 status)	\$30.00
Set-up Deposit (for all licenses) (refundable within 48 hrs. after end of event upon inspector's verification of on-time set-up)	\$60.00
(7) Farmer's Market (season)	\$50.00
(g) Swimming pools (non-residential)	\$300.00
(h) Toilets, portable	
First installation	\$15.00
Each additional installation	\$5.00
(i) Foodservice Workers Certification Courses	
(1) Food Managers	\$185.00
(2) Food Handlers	\$75.00
(3) Late registration fee	\$15.00

All other portions of Chapter 6, "Fees and Fee Schedule" shall remain unchanged.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as required by law.
