Descriptions of New Election District Boundaries

March 18, 2022

The following Geographic Information Systems (GIS) data resources were provided by the NJDEP Stream centerlines 2015; NJDOT Street centerlines 2015; TeleAtlas Street centerlines 2010. The parcels (2021) were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the New Jersey Geographic Information Network (NJGIN). The municipal boundaries 2021, were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the NJ Office of GIS (NJOIT). This source data was utilized for the preparation of the election district word description as stipulated under N.J.S.A. 19:4-13 et seq., as required by Administrative Law 13:17-3.1 for submission to the Office of the New Jersey Secretary of State (SOS).

The City of Englewood in the County of Bergen in the State of New Jersey is comprised of a total of Sixteen (16) Election Districts, which are, in turn, located within Four (4) Wards. Due to population changes and other concerns documented during Census 2020, new boundaries for these Election Districts are required to meet New Jersey Statute Title 15 (NJAC: 15:10-3 Election District Maps) and Title 19 (NJSA: 19:4-13 Elections) guidelines and the City's current needs. The new boundaries for these Election Districts are described herein.

Ward One

Ward One/Election District One

The First Election District in the First Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Engle Street (County Route 501) is intersected by the physical centerline of Booth Avenue;

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Engle Street (County Route 501), to intersect the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505) and Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Franklin Street;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Franklin Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Dwight Place;

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Dwight Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Maple Street;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Maple Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Dana Place;

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Dana Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of E. Linden Avenue;

Ward One/Election District One (cont'd)

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of E. Linden Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Jones Road;

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Jones Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to a point approximately 690 feet southeast of North Woodland Street, where said physical centerline is parallel to the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border;

Proceed, Northeast, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border, where said border crosses the physical centerline of Pershing Avenue and Chestnut Street and runs roughly parallel to North Woodland Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Booth Avenue;

Turn, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Booth Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Engle Street (County Route 501), which is also the point of beginning.

Ward One/Election District Two

The Second Election District in the First Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of North Dean Street is intersected by the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border;

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of North Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Brownes Terrace;

Proceed, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Brownes Terrace, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Engle Street (County Route 501);

Head, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Engle Street (County Route 501), to intersect the physical centerline of Booth Avenue;

Travel, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Booth Avenue, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border;

Go, Northeast, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border, where said border runs roughly parallel to North Woodland Street, to its point of intersection with the south side of Illingworth Avenue, where the latter forms the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border.

Turn, Northwest, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border, crossing Highview Road, then Elkwood Terrace, then Whitewood Road and then Serpentine Road, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of North Dean Street, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward One/Election District Three

The Third Election District in the First Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Tenafly Road is intersected by the physical centerline of West Hudson Road;

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Tenafly Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Hamilton Avenue;

Continue, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of West Hamilton Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of North Dean Street;

Proceed, North, following along the physical centerline of North Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Hudson Road;

Turn, West, following along the physical centerline of West Hudson Road, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of Tenafly Road, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward One/Election District Four

The Fourth Election District in the First Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Tenafly Road is intersected by the physical centerline of West Hamilton Avenue;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of West Hamilton Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of North Dean Street;

Proceed, North, following along the physical centerline of North Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Brownes Terrace;

Continue, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Brownes Terrace, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Engle Street;

Head, South, following along the physical centerline of Engle Street (County Route 501), to intersect the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Go, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line;

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Demarest Avenue;

Turn, Northwest, again following along the physical centerline of West Demarest Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Tenafly Road;

Ward One/Election District Four (cont'd)

Move, North, following along the physical centerline of Tenafly Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Hamilton Avenue, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two

Ward Two/Election District One

The First Election District in the Second Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Jones Road is intersected by the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Jones Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue;

Go, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue to its terminus, where said terminus is parallel to the northern boundary of tax assessment property line of block 3601, Lot 4;

Thence, East then South, following along the boundary of tax assessment property line of block 3601, Lot 4, to its point of intersection with the shoreline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway);

Continue, South, following in a straight line to intersect the centerline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway);

Proceed, East then Southeast then South, following along the centerline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway) through its various courses, to its point of intersection with the southern boundary of tax assessment block limit line of block 3601, where said boundary runs parallel to an extension of the north side of Middlesex Avenue;

Go, East, following along the southern boundary of tax assessment block limit line of block 3601 for a distance of approximately 50 feet to intersect the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border;

Continue, Northeast, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border and portions of the physical centerline of Summit Street, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Head, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Jones Road, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two/Election District Two

The Second Election District in the Second Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), is intersected by the physical centerline of Franklin Street;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Franklin Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Dwight Place;

Continue, North, following along the physical centerline of Dwight Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Maple Street;

Turn, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Maple Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Dana Place;

Head, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Dana Place, to intersect the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue;

Go, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue to its terminus, where said terminus is parallel to the northern boundary of tax assessment property line of block 3601, Lot 4;

Thence, East then South, following along the boundary of tax assessment property line of block 3601, Lot 4, to its point of intersection with the shoreline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway);

Continue, South, following in a straight line to intersect the centerline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway);

Proceed, Southwest then West then Southeast, following along the centerline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway) through its various courses, to a point where said centerline passes beneath the physical centerline of Middlesex Avenue, just east of Monmouth Street;

Head, West, following along the physical centerline of Middlesex Street, to intersect the physical centerline of Jones Road;

Go, South, following along the physical centerline of Jones Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Sunset Avenue;

Turn, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Sunset Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Broad Avenue;

Move, South, following along the physical centerline of Broad Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Madison Avenue;

Proceed, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Madison Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Audubon Road;

Continue, Northerly, following along the physical centerline of Audubon Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Meadowbrook Road;

Ward Two/Election District Two (cont'd)

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Meadowbrook Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93);

Continue, Northerly, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue;

Turn, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue, to intersect the physical centerline of South Dean Street;

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of South Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Garrett Place;

Head, East, following along the physical centerline of Garrett Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93);

Go, South, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Franklin Street, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two/Election District Three

The Third Election District in the Second Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), is intersected by the physical centerline of Meadowbrook Road;

Thence, Southerly, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Van Nostrand Avenue;

Turn, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Van Nostrand Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of South Dean Street;

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of South Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Rockwood Place;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Rockwood Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of East Sheffield Avenue;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of East Sheffield Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Lake Street;

Thence, Northeast then Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Lake Street, crossing over the physical centerline of Lake Court, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Broad Avenue;

Ward Two/Election District Three (cont'd)

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Broad Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4;

Thence, Southerly, following along the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grandview Avenue, which is also the City of Englewood/Borough of Fort Lee, Bergen County shared border;

Proceed, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Grandview Avenue, following the City of Englewood/Borough of Fort Lee, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said border turns sharply northeast;

Move, Northeast, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Fort Lee, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border, near the extended physical centerline of Cumberland Street;

Go, West then Northeast then East then Northeast again, following the City of Englewood/Borough of Englewood Cliffs, Bergen County shared border and a portion of the physical centerline of Summit Street, to a point where said border intersects the southern boundary of tax assessment property line of block 3601, and said block limit line runs parallel to an extension of the north side of Middlesex Avenue;

Travel, West, following along the southern boundary of tax assessment property line of block 3601 for a distance of approximately 50 feet, to intersect the centerline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway);

Proceed, North then West then Southwest then West then Southeast, following along the centerline of Flat Rock Brook (a waterway) through its various courses, and following the perimeter of lands of Allison Park, to a point where said centerline passes beneath the physical centerline of Middlesex Avenue, just east of the physical centerline of Monmouth Street;

Head, West, following along the physical centerline of Middlesex Street, to intersect the physical centerline of Jones Road;

Go, South, following along the physical centerline of Jones Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Sunset Avenue;

Turn, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Sunset Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Broad Avenue;

Move, South, following along the physical centerline of Broad Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Madison Avenue;

Proceed, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Madison Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Audubon Avenue;

Proceed, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Audubon Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Meadowbrook Road;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Meadowbrook Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two/Election District Four

The Fourth Election District in the Second Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of South Dean Street is intersected by the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4;

Proceed, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4, to a point where said centerline crosses over the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line;

Head, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Forest Avenue (County Route 64);

Proceed, Northwest then West, following along the physical centerline of West Forest Avenue (County Route 64), to intersect the physical centerline of Harold Avenue;

Go, Southerly, following along the physical centerline of Harold Avenue, to its terminus, at the physical centerline of Tietjen Avenue;

Continue, Southerly, following in a straight line from the terminus of Harold Avenue, for approximately 25 feet, to intersect the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border;

Turn, East, to follow the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, where said border runs roughly parallel to the physical centerline of Tietjen Avenue, to a point approximately 25 feet west of the physical centerline of Overpeck Avenue, where said border turns sharply southwest;

Proceed, Southwest, following along the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, where said border crosses the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Cedar Lane;

Continue, East, following along the physical centerline of Cedar Lane for a distance of approximately 180 feet, where said centerline forms the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said border turns southwest again to follow lands of Overpeck Park;

Go, Southwest, following along the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, following lands of Overpeck Park, to a point where said border intersects the City of Englewood/Borough of Leonia, Bergen County shared border, at the southwest corner of lands of Overpeck Park;

Head, Easterly then Southeast, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Leonia, Bergen County shared border, where said border crosses the centerline of Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line, Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), Broad Avenue and Ridgeland Terrace, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4 and the physical centerline of Grandview Avenue, which is also a point on the City of Englewood/Borough of Fort Lee, Bergen County shared border;

Thence, Northerly, following along the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of Broad Avenue;

Ward Two/Election District Four (cont'd)

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Broad Avenue, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of Lake Street;

Thence, Northwest then Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Lake Street, crossing over the physical centerline of Lake Court, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of East Sheffield Avenue;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of East Sheffield Avenue, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93);

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of Rockwood Place;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Rockwood Place, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of South Dean Street;

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of South Dean Street, to a point where said border intersects the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4, which is also the point of beginning.

The First Election District in the Third Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of John Street is intersected by the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road (County Route 505);

Thence, East, following along the physical centerline of John Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Tenafly Road;

Travel, South, following along the physical centerline of Tenafly Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Demarest Avenue;

Continue, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of West Demarest Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line;

Proceed, South, following along the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line, to intersect the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Go, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Cleveland Street;

Head, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Cleveland Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Liberty Road;

Ward Three/Election District One (cont'd)

Turn, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Liberty Road, to intersect the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road (County Route 505);

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of John Street, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Three/Election District Two

The Second Election District in the Third Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of John Street is intersected by the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road (County Route 505);

Thence, East, following along the physical centerline of John Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Tenafly Road;

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of Tenafly Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Hudson Avenue;

Travel, East, following along the physical centerline of West Hudson Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of North Dean Street;

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of North Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border;

Travel, Westerly, following along the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Tenafly Road;

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of Tenafly Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Ivy Lane (County Route S68), where said centerline forms the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border;

Proceed, West, following along the physical centerline of West Ivy Lane (County Route S68), where said centerline forms the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road (County Route 505);

Continue, South, following along the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of John Street, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Three/Election District Three

The Third Election District in the Third Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Tryon Avenue is intersected by the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road;

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Tryon Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Liberty Road;

Proceed, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Liberty Road, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border;

Turn, North, following along the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Ivy Lane (County Route S68), where said centerline forms the City of Englewood/Borough of Bergenfield, Bergen County shared border;

Travel, East, following along the physical centerline of West Ivy Lane (County Route S68), following the City of Englewood/Borough of Bergenfield, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border, near the physical centerline of Manor Road;

Continue, East, following along the physical centerline of West Ivy Lane (County Route S68), following the City of Englewood/Borough of Tenafly, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road;

Head, South, following along the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Tryon Avenue, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Three/Election District Four

The Fourth Election District in the Third Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Tryon Avenue is intersected by the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road;

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Tryon Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Liberty Road;

Proceed, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Liberty Road, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border;

Continue, South, following along the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue;

Go, Southeast; following along the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Cleveland Street;

Ward Three/Election District Four (cont'd)

Head, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Cleveland Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Liberty Road;

Turn, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Liberty Road, to intersect the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road;

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of Knickerbocker Road, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Tryon Avenue, which is also the point of beginning.

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline William Street is intersected by the physical centerline of First Street;

Head, West, following along the physical centerline of First Street, to a point where said centerline crosses over the centerline of Metzler Brook (a waterway);

Thence, North, following along the centerline of Metzler Brook (a waterway), through its courses, to a point where said centerline passes beneath the physical centerline of Third Street, at its terminus;

Travel, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Third Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Lafayette Place;

Go, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Englewood Avenue;

Proceed, Southeasterly, following along the physical centerline of West Englewood Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of William Street;

Proceed, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of William Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of First Street, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Four/Election District Two

The Second Election District in the Fourth Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline Rosemont Place is intersected by the physical centerline of Lafayette Place;

Ward Four/Election District Two (cont'd)

Go, North, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Englewood Avenue;

Continue, West, following along the physical centerline of West Englewood Avenue, for a short distance, to intersect the physical centerline of Mattlage Place;

Travel, North, following along the physical centerline of Mattlage Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Head, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border;

Turn, South, following along the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Rosemont Place;

Proceed, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Rosemont Place, from the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said centerline and border is intersected by the physical centerline of Lafayette Place, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Four/Election District Three

The Third Election District in the Fourth Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), is intersected by the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue;

Go, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line and the physical centerline of West Linden Avenue;

Continue, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of West Linden Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of William Street;

Turn, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of William Street, to intersect the physical centerline of First Street;

Head, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of First Street, to a point where said centerline crosses over the centerline of Metzler Brook (a waterway);

Thence, North, following along the centerline of Metzler Brook (a waterway), through its courses, to a point where said centerline passes beneath the physical centerline of Third Street, at its terminus;

Travel, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Third Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Lafayette Place;

Ward Four/Election District Three (cont'd)

Proceed, South, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Rosemont Place;

Go, West, following along the physical centerline of Rosemont Place, to its point of intersection with the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border;

Head, Southwest then Southeast, following along the City of Englewood/Township of Teaneck, Bergen County shared border, to its point of intersection with the extended physical centerline of Harold Avenue;

Travel, North, following along the extended physical centerline of Harold Avenue, for a distance of approximately 25 feet, to intersect the physical centerline of Harold Avenue and physical centerline of Tietjen Avenue;

Continue, North, following along the physical centerline of Harold Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Forest Avenue (County Route 64);

Proceed, East then Southeast, following along the physical centerline of West Forest Avenue (County Route 64), to intersect the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line;

Turn, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line, to a point where said centerline passes beneath the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4;

Go, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 4, to a point where said centerline crosses over the physical centerline of South Dean Street;

Head, North, following along the physical centerline of South Dean Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Van Nostrand Avenue;

Continue, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Van Nostrand Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93);

Travel, Northerly, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Four/Election District Four

The Fourth Election District in the Fourth Ward of the City of Englewood shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), is intersected by the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Garrett Place;

Ward Four/Election District Four (cont'd)

Proceed, West, following along the physical centerline of Garrett Place, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of South Dean Street;

Head, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of South Dean Street, to intersect the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue;

Go, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of East Linden Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of the Conrail Northern Railroad of New Jersey Branch Line and the physical centerline of West Linden Avenue;

Travel, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of the West Linden Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of William Street;

Continue, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of William Street, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of West Englewood Avenue;

Proceed, Northwesterly, following in a straight line along the extended physical centerline of West Englewood Avenue, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Mattlage Place;

Turn, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Mattlage Place, to intersect the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505);

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of West Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Grand Avenue (N.J. State Highway Route 93) and the physical centerline of East Palisade Avenue (County Route 505), which is also the point of beginning.

The City of Englewood is located in Legislative District Thirty-Seven and Congressional District Five.
