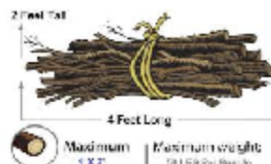
Christmas trees are collected curbside on designated

place trees in plastic bags.



2024 Christmas Tree Collections
between
December 30 to February 7

Yard Debris must be Curbside before 7:00am

- Traditional or plastic garbage container
- Biodegradable paper bags
- Twigs and branches bundled up and tied to 4" in diameter
- No plastic bags
- Containers are not to exceed 50lbs.



Household/METAL/APPLIANCE RECYCLING




Metal (201) 568-3401

- Metal and appliance items are picked up by APPOINTMENT ONLY on Fridays.
- Call (201) 568-3401 to schedule your appointment.
- Approved items must be put curbside before 7:00am on the date of the appointment.
- Unapproved items will not be collected and will remain the responsibility of the homeowner.
- Examples: Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, washers, dryers, heaters and stoves.
- Copper, Brass, Iron, Steel, Aluminum, etc.
- Oversize items such as household appliances constructed of metal.
Item has to be 70% metal.
- No more than three (3) items for metal pick up.
- Drop off - Daily Monday through Friday 9:00am to 2:00pm



All residents entering the recycling yard must provide proof of residency when using the recycling yard.
Contractors will not be permitted to enter or use the center on a resident's behalf.

PET WASTE AND WATER POLLUTION



The City of Englewood has adopted and enforces an ordinance that requires immediate and proper disposal of solid pet waste deposited on any property not owned or possessed by the pet owner or keeper. Please visit our website for more information:

Pet waste is carried by rain, melting snow, and ice to storm drains that empty into rivers, lakes, and the ocean. It also reaches reservoirs which supply much of the drinking water in New Jersey.

Pollution due to pet waste negatively impacts swimming, boating and fishing in these water bodies.

Pet waste contains microorganisms that can cause bacterial diseases, roundworms and parasitic infections.

In addition, pet waste contains harmful levels of nutrients which promote excessive algae and plant growth. This can rob the waterbody of oxygen, potentially killing all aquatic life in the area. Such nutrient pollution also causes waters to become cloudy and green.

Proper Pet Waste Disposal

WHAT CAN BE LEFT AT THE RECYCLING YARD?

The Recycling Yard accepts Paper/Cardboard, Plastic/Metal/Glass, Electronic Waste, Metal and Appliances, and Books. **NONE** of these items should be placed with regular garbage. When leaving items at the Recycling Yard please follow these instructions:

- **BREAK DOWN** and flatten all cardboard boxes—do not leave packing material in boxes.
- Take all items out of plastic bags. Recycle plastic bags at DPW Yard or your local grocery store.
- The Recycling Center **CANNOT** accept Styrofoam. Place Styrofoam in regular garbage.
- Please do not place regular garbage in **ANY** of the recycling containers.

LEAF COMPOST DROP-OFF FACILITY

Residents may bring their leaves to Recycling Yard during the week between 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

No professional landscapers are allowed to use this facility. Seasonal weekend hours are posted on the website at www.cityofenglewood.org

LEAF DISPOSAL GUIDED BY STATE DEP STORMWATER RULES

NJDEP Storm water Pollution Prevention regulations require us to change how we think about the disposal of leaves. For reasons of safety, environmental protection and to maintain a tidy appearance around the City, we encourage you to either mulch mow, compost or dispose of your leaves in biodegradable paper bags. If you bag your leaves, please remember the following rules.

- Containers no larger than 50lbs.
- Leaves should be set out only in biodegradable paper bags
- Leaves that are set out in plastic bags will not be collected
- Leaves set out for collection must be free of limbs and branches
- 10 inches away from storm drains

All residents entering the recycling yard and the transfer station must provide proof of residency when using the recycling yard.

Contractors will not be permitted to enter or use the center on a resident's behalf.

ELECTRONIC WASTE DROP-OFF FACILITY (E-WASTE RECYCLING)

Electronic Waste Recycling can be dropped off at the Recycling Yard located at 175 South Van Brunt Street, Daily Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 2:00pm. Saturdays as noted in calendar.

Fire Prevention Tips

Make Sure there is a Working Smoke Detector on every level of your home.

Plan two ways out of your home in event of a fire and practice that plan.

Careless smoking is the leading cause of fire deaths in North America.

Matches and Lighters are for adults only. Store them up high, away from kids.

Always stay near cooking to monitor it closely. Keep cooking areas clear of combustibles and wear clothes with short, rolled up sleeves to prevent burns.

Keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from combustibles. Never plug them into extensions cords. Always shut them off before you go to sleep.

Always charge electronics with the original charger to prevent fires. Never place a charging cell phone under a pillow while you sleep.

Store a fire extinguisher on every level of your home. Make sure it has an ABC rating suitable for any type of fire.

Blow out all candles before you leave a room or go to bed. Consider using flameless candles as a safer alternative.

STORMWATER POLLUTION: WHAT DO YOU THINK?

- You may think littering is no big deal (it is).
- You may think that whatever runs into the storm drains gets treated before it reaches local rivers and streams (it isn't).
- You may think motor oil and other hazardous materials doesn't harm the water very much (it does).

Pollution seeps into the ground and is carried by stormwater (rain and snow) directly to our drinking water, streams, lakes and oceans. Contaminated stormwater is the #1 cause of water pollution in New Jersey. Simple things, like proper clean-up after oneself and careful use of chemicals in the home, office and yard, are helpful ways for businesses and residents to protect the water.

The City of Englewood has ordinances aimed at reducing pollution from litter, fertilizer, oil, pesticides, detergents, animal waste, grass clippings and other debris. For details, see if you can take time and visit our website . Thank you for keeping them in mind and doing your share.

How do I report a streetlight outage?

You can log into PSEG.com and register for PSE&G MyAccount. Once logged in, click on Outages & Leaks. Next, click on Report Streetlight Outage. You can also call 1-800-436-7734.

It is important to provide information regarding the location and status of the streetlight. One of the most important pieces of information is the pole number. If there is no pole number on the pole, give the full address of the home or business in front of which the pole is located, or provide the pole numbers of the poles on either side of the malfunctioning light. If the pole is at an intersection, provide the names of the two streets.

Landmarks such as schools, libraries, train stations, etc., are other good identifying pieces of information for pole locations. If the pole is in a parking lot, provide the name of the business where the parking lot is located.

It is helpful to tell us the current condition of the streetlight. Is it out? Is it going on and off? Is it on during the day? Is it making unusual sounds? Are the light, and/or the pole missing? This information should be provided when you report a streetlight outage to help us identify the problem.

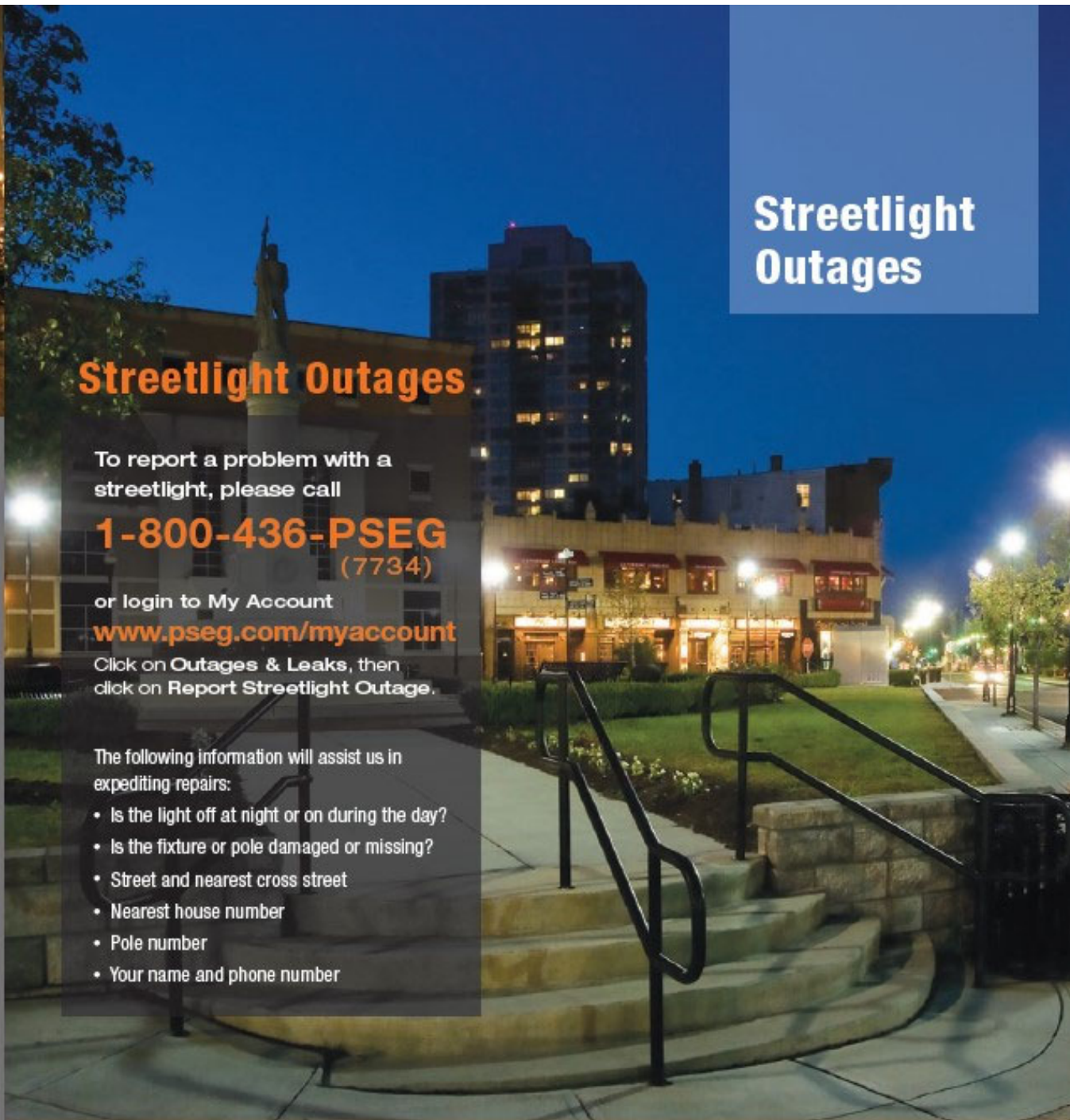

The following information will assist us in expediting repairs:

- Is the light off at night or on during the day?
- Is the fixture or pole damaged or missing?
- Street and nearest cross street
- Nearest house number
- Pole number
- Your name and phone number

We can use your assistance by letting us know when they are not operating properly.



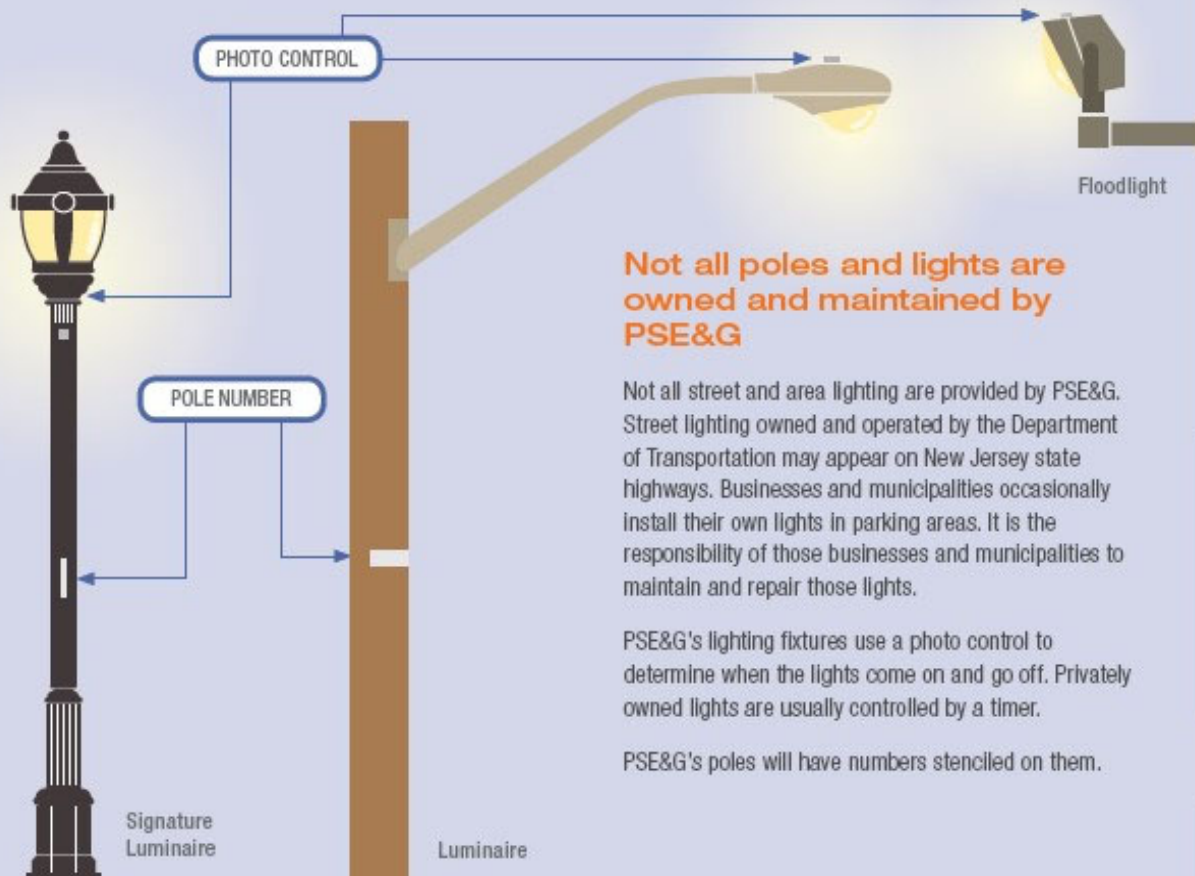
How does the streetlight get repaired or replaced?

After a report is received by PSE&G, a lamp inspector will investigate the problem. The majority of streetlight malfunctions are related to a light bulb or photo cell. The lamp inspector will replace the complete streetlight head if the repair is more complicated. Once reported, repairs are usually completed within a few days.

If there is no power to the light, the streetlight outage report is referred to the engineering department to investigate. Repairs typically consist of replacement of the pole, or repair/replacement of the supply wiring, and take additional time to complete.

The customer will be provided with the name and phone number of the engineering technician doing the investigation.

Once the source of the problem is determined, the engineering technician will create work orders for the underground or overhead construction department to complete repairs. The customer can call the engineering technician directly for updates on the repair of the light.

Solutions to Stormwater Pollution

Easy Things You Can Do Every Day To Protect Our Water

A Guide to Healthy Habits for Cleaner Water

Pollution on streets, parking lots and lawns is washed by rain into storm drains, then directly to our drinking water supplies and the ocean and lakes our children play in. Fertilizer, oil, pesticides, detergents, pet waste, grass clippings: You name it and it ends up in our water.

Stormwater pollution is one of New Jersey's greatest threats to clean and plentiful water, and that's why we're all doing something about it.

By sharing the responsibility and making small, easy changes in our daily lives, we can keep common pollutants out of stormwater. It all adds up to cleaner water, and it saves the high cost of cleaning up once it's dirty.

As part of New Jersey's initiative to keep our water clean and plentiful and to meet federal requirements, many municipalities and other public agencies including colleges and military bases must adopt ordinances or other rules prohibiting various activities that contribute to stormwater pollution. Breaking these rules can result in fines or other penalties.



As a resident, business, or other member of the New Jersey community, it is important to know these easy things you can do every day to protect our water.

Limit your use of fertilizers and pesticides

- Do a soil test to see if you need a fertilizer.
- Do not apply fertilizers if heavy rain is predicted.
- Look into alternatives for pesticides.
- Maintain a small lawn and keep the rest of your property or yard in a natural state with trees and other native vegetation that requires little or no fertilizer.
- If you use fertilizers and pesticides, follow the instructions on the label on how to correctly apply it.



Make sure you properly store or discard any unused portions.

Properly use and dispose of hazardous products

- Hazardous products include some household or commercial cleaning products, lawn and garden care products, motor oil, antifreeze, and paints.
- Do not pour any hazardous products down a storm drain because storm drains are usually connected to local water bodies and the water is not treated.

- If you have hazardous products in your home or workplace, make sure you store or dispose of them properly. Read the label for guidance.

- Use natural or less toxic alternatives when possible.

- Recycle used motor oil.

- Contact your municipality, county or facility management office for the locations of hazardous-waste disposal facilities.



Keep pollution out of storm drains

- Municipalities and many other public agencies are required to mark certain storm drain inlets with messages reminding people that storm drains are connected to local waterbodies.

- Do not let sewage or other wastes flow into a stormwater system.

Clean up after your pet

- Many municipalities and public agencies must enact and enforce local pet-waste rules.

- An example is requiring pet owners or their keepers to pick up and properly dispose of pet waste dropped on public or other people's property.

- Make sure you know your town's or agency's requirements and comply with them. It's the law. And remember to:

- Use newspaper, bags or pooper-scoopers to pick up wastes.

- Dispose of the wrapped pet waste in the trash or unwrapped in a toilet.

- Never discard pet waste in a storm drain.

Don't feed wildlife

- Do not feed wildlife, such as ducks and geese, in public areas.

- Many municipalities and other public agencies must enact and enforce a rule that prohibits wildlife feeding in these areas.



Don't litter

- Place litter in trash receptacles.

- Recycle. Recycle. Recycle.

- Participate in community cleanups.

Dispose of yard waste properly

- Keep leaves and grass out of storm drains.

- If your municipality or agency has yard waste collection rules, follow them.

- Use leaves and grass clippings as a resource for compost.

- Use a mulching mower that recycles grass clippings into the lawn.
